Job Title: Youth Basketball Coach

SUMMARY:

Under the general supervision of the Recreation Supervisor this individual will be able to assist our head basketball coach in teaching the fundamentals of basketball to K-4th grade boys and girls. Basic skills required include shooting, dribbling, and passing.

SUPERVISORY:

The Youth Basketball Coach directly reports to the Recreation Supervisor

ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES:

- Responsible for usage of all basketball equipment
- Provide a safe, fun and challenging class to each student
- Teach the practice at the set schedule time
- Attend all required YBL meetings
- Follow and adhere to the park district's employee policies
- Return all basketball equipment to its proper place after each practice or game.
- Clock in and out each day you are schedule to work
- Never communicate any negative opinions about the park district to students or clientele

MARGINAL FUNCTIONS:

- Attend Park District meetings as necessary.

PSYCHOLOGICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Ability to work independently in day-to-day operations.
- Ability to work in a team atmosphere.
- Must be able to function effectively in a fast-paced environment.
- Must be able to deal with people under stressful and demanding situations.
- Ability to maintain positive and effective working relationships with coaches, supervisors and other staff members.
- Must wear required park district uniform

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- General work area is indoors, in a smoke-free environment, with controlled temperature and fluorescent lighting.
- Perform tasks that require walking, running, dribbling, shooting and passing
- Performs lifting tasks up to 25 pounds.

HOURS:

Depending on the assigned practice times per week.

A High School Degree or Higher and Valid Illinois State Driver's License (Class A).
