Prefiling Notice of the April 6, 2027 Consolidated Election for the office of Park District Commissioner

Two Park Commissioner offices will be up for election on the April 6, 2027 Consolidated Election Ballot. The office of a Park Commissioner serves a six-year term. Oak Brook Park District residents of one year or more are eligible to seek this office.

Prospective candidates seeking the office of Park Commissioner for the Oak Brook Park District may either pick up candidate packets at the Oak Brook Park District Administrative Office, 1450 Forest Gate Road, Oak Brook, IL 60523 beginning August 25 2026, Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, or Packets may be obtained in PDF format for email delivery by contacting Laure L. Kosey, Executive Director lkosey@obparks.org.

Candidate packets are provided as a courtesy of the Oak Brook Park District. Each candidate is urged to seek legal counsel to determine individual requirements for running for elected office.

Potential candidates can begin circulating petitions on Tuesday, August 25, 2026.

Candidate petitions/certificates of nomination will be accepted at the Oak Brook Park District Administration Office beginning Monday, November 16, 2026 through Tuesday, November 23, 2026. The Administration Office is closed on Saturday and Sunday. Office hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
